



# Good Tidings Bracelet Tutorial

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
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## Material list for Good Tidings Bracelet:


- A- Seed beads 8/0- 15 gr
- B- Seed beads 11/0- 10 gr
- C- Seed beads 15/0- 8 gr
- Fire polished 4mm- 25 pc
- Swarovski 4mm – 50 pc
- Magnetic clasp 6mm

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
# Good tidings Bracelet




1. On a comfortable length of thread, pick up 8 A beads. Pick up 2 A beads, skip the next 2 beads in the row and go through the next 2. Pick up 2 A beads, skip the next 2 beads in the row and exit the bottom. Work this way in two drop peyote for the length of the bracelet.



2. Reaching the end of the bracelet, pick up 2 B beads and go through the next 2 beads. Repeat one more time. Using 11/0 beads at the end of the row will even out the edges of the bracelet.




3. Coming out of the first set of beads at the beginning of the bracelet, pick up 2C and 5 B beads. Go back through the 4<sup>th</sup> B bead and pick up 3 B and 2 C beads. Skipping an A bead in the base go down through the next to beads and up again through the next set of 2's. Continue in this matter to the end of the bracelet. Step down through the bracelet adding 2B beads in the gaps. Step up through the first 3 A beads and down through the next 3 A beads so that you are effectively exiting the 3<sup>rd</sup> set of A beads at the bottom.




4. Repeat step 3 on the other side of the bracelet. The arches of the second side should be facing the gap between the arches on the first side. At the end of this row, step up through the bracelet and out of the first arch on the other side. Step up and out of the top 11/0 bead.


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
5. On the right side of the bracelet, pick up 1FP and go through the top bead of left side arch. Pick up another FP and go through the top bead on the next right side arch. Repeat to the end of the bracelet. Coming out of the last arch, go through all the B beads of the arch down to the beginning of the bracelet. Loop your thread around between the 11/0's and 15/0s of the last arch and come back up to the top bead again in preparation for the next round.



6. Pick up \* 1A, 1B, 1SW, 1B, 1A\* and go through the next top B on each arch from the previous round. Add \*-\* through the length of the bracelet and step up through the 8/0 base beads and back up through the arch on the second side of the bracelet. Repeat \*-\* on the second side of the bracelet. Step out through the first 8/0 bead of the base.



7. Coming out of the first A bead in the base, pick up 1A, 1B, 1A, 1B, 1A, skip the next bead of the base and go down through the next A bead in the base. Step up through the following A bead and repeat till the end of the bracelet length. Step up through the base to exit the other side of the bracelet. Repeat this step on the other side for the full length.



8. Coming out of the second A (8/0) bead of the new arch, pick up 1B, 1SW, 1B and to through the third A bead of the next round (top bead). Repeat all around the bracelet. Add clasp to each end of the bracelet.
